CLOC Board Members,

The following is an update report of key factors of the current COVID-19 pandemic situation at CLOC.

1- Updated test results report of the 3 current “Outbreak” locations: (see attached *Tracking Report for details*)

Kildeer:

4 clients: positive - in isolation
8 staff: positive - in isolation
1 staff: negative
1 staff: waiting on result

Holcan :

3 client: positive - in isolation
2 clients: waiting on results
1 staff : positive (involved in cross-over to 425 Adelaide)
2 staff : negative

425 Adelaide :

1 client: positive - hospitalized, on respirator Dec. 25, condition improving
3 client: positive - in isolation
2 clients: waiting on results
1 staff: positive - in isolation
1 staff: negative
1 staff: waiting on result

* Note: Waiting for results for 1 client at Pinecrest, a non-outbreak residence.

2- Current overall COVID-19 situation at CLOC for all locations (see attached *Tracking Report for details*)

202 Clients and Staff tested ; 27 Positive test results ; waiting for 10 test results (since March 2020)

3- Existing potential “risk” situation

As all current positive and waiting test results present a potential risk depending on status of recovery, there is one present situation, where a staff member who allegedly was infected with COVID at the Kildeer residence, who could have passed COVID to her father, who is now hospitalised in a critical condition on a respirator, This could present a risk.

4- Staffing

The staffing and shift coverage for residences remains stable and manageable.

5- MCCSS concern of CLOC COVID-19 situation and outbreaks.

CLOC senior management keep constant and on-going contact with the Ministry of the existing situation and actions regarding the current 3 outbreak locations. The Ministry is satisfied with CLOC's management of the situation.

It is noted that there are another 15 COVID-19 outbreaks in the local DS sector organisations.
