- *along with other summer staff develop an online learning program for summer* that would take into account their interests and goals, while assisting with the development of daily living skills, social skills, and community awareness
- assist in the development of weekly schedule of activities that individuals could sign up to participate in
- assist the summer participants in experiencing a variety of activities that enhances a learning experience during the summer months, taking into consideration that all plans are age appropriate
- maintain accurate records for each participant on progress made, activities and skills acquired
- keep lines of communication open with individual and their family to ensure weekly activities and support are meeting their expectations
- work co-operatively with other members of the summer program and other agency staff
